

PIKAS PPV – SABAH INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTRE (SICC)
FACTSHEET / FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Sabah International Convention Centre (SICC) is the appointed venue for the Public-Private Partnership COVID-19 Industry Immunisation Programme (PIKAS) vaccination centre, aimed at employees of companies registered under Ministry of Trade and Industry (MITI). For more information, refer to;

Q: Where will the vaccinations be held at Sabah International Convention Centre (SICC)

A: vaccinations will be conducted at exhibition hall – Kinabatangan Hall I – III, Level 2.

Q: When will SICC open officially as PIKAS PPV?

A: SICC will be opened as PIKAS vaccination centre on 17th July 2021.

Q: Where is the carpark designated for the vaccination programme at SICC?

A: Carparks are available at Level 2. Starting from 1st July, there will be charge of car park fee per entry. (applicable for cars only, free entry for motorcycles)

Description	Car Park Rate
1 st – 15 minutes (Grace period)	Free (no validation needed)
Flat Rate - Visitors	RM3.00 per entry after 15 minutes

Q: Is there any ride-hailing services to SICC?

A: Yes, Grab is available.

Q: What should I do if I experience a reaction after receiving the vaccination?

A: If it happens while you are at the Centre, healthcare professionals will be there to assist you.

Q: What if I experience the side effects at home?

Q: I have mild medical condition which I am unsure if I am eligible to take the vaccine. Can I still get it?

A: Prior to receiving your vaccination, you would be interviewed by a qualified doctor to approve the inoculation process.

Q: Who can I ask about allergy, health concerns and medication issues?

A: You may ask the doctor during consultation. Bring your medication to show to the doctor during consultation.

Q: Will there be food and beverages available in SICC?

A: Food and beverages is available for purchase at the vaccination area at Level 2.

Q: Is it safe to be at SICC?

A: The centre is sanitized on a daily basis, your health and safety is our priority. There is only one entrance and exit point designated for the vaccination programme.

Q: What should I prepare prior and during my vaccination appointment?

A: Please follow the basic Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) below:

No.	Things to remember
1	Wear your mask all the time and stay at least 1 meter away from other people.
2	Conduct temperature check and check in to MySejahtera app upon your arrival to SICC.
3	Make sure to keep your hand clean by washing your hands or use a hand sanitizer.
4	Be punctual for your appointment. Visitors are encouraged to arrive 30 minutes before their appointment.
5	Please bring along the following items; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NRIC / Passport • Pen • Mobile phone • List of medication taken (if any)
6	Put on loose apparel especially on the arm area for an easy jab. You may opt for a t-shirt with a sleeve that can be easily folded up for the vaccination.
7	Please informed your Healthcare Organiser (HCO) immediately in you have contracted COVID-19 or symptoms.
8	Follow the directional signage according to your assigned Healthcare Organiser (HCO). The information is provided on your appointment details in the MySejahtera app.
9	Stay alert and kindly follow the instructions from officers around SICC.
